

# Privacy Policy

## 1. Scope of this privacy policy

1.1. This privacy policy applies only to the actions of **NAGYEDi** and Users with respect to this Website. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this Website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.

1.2. For purposes of the applicable Data Protection Laws, NAGYEDi is the "data controller". This means that NAGYEDi determines the purposes for which, and the manner in which, your Data is processed.

## 2. Who we are

## 3. What data we collect and why we collect it

3.1. We may collect both "Non-Personal Information" and "Personal Information" about you. "Non-Personal Information" includes information that cannot be used to personally identify you, such as anonymous usage data, general demographic information we may collect, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform types, preferences you submit and preferences that are generated based on the data you submit and number of clicks. "Personal Information" includes information that can be used to personally identify you, such as your name, address and email address.

3.2. In addition, we may also track information provided to us by your browser when you view or use the Service, such as the website you came from (known as the "referring URL"), the type of browser you use, the device from which you connected to the Service, the time and date of access, and other information that does not personally identify you. We use this information for, among other things, the operation of the Service, to maintain the quality of the Service, to provide general statistics regarding use of the Service and for other business purposes. We track this information using cookies, or small text files which include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to a user's browser from our servers and are stored on the user's computer hard drive. Sending a cookie to a user's browser enables us to collect Non-Personal Information about that user and keep a record of the user's preferences when utilizing our services, both on an individual and aggregate basis. The Business may use both persistent and session cookies; persistent cookies remain on your computer after you close your session and until you delete them, while session cookies expire when you close your browser. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your Internet browser help file directions. If you choose to disable cookies, some areas of the Service may not work properly.

### 3.2.1. Comments

3.2.1.1. When visitors would like to leave comments on blogposts (on the NEWS subpage), they would need to create a profile. We collect basic personal data such as email address, name, optionally phone number, and password. When visitors leave comments on the site we collect the data shown in the comments form, and also the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to help spam detection.

3.2.1.2. When visitors leave comments on the site we collect the data shown in the comments form, and also the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to help spam detection.

### 3.2.2. Media

3.2.2.1. If you upload *images* to the website (for your user profile), you should avoid uploading images with embedded location data (EXIF GPS) included. Visitors to the website can download and extract any location data from images on the website.

### **3.2.3. Cookies**

3.2.3.1. During the course of any visit to our site, the pages you see, along with a short text file called a 'cookie', are downloaded to your computer. Many websites do this, because cookies facilitate useful features such as the ability to identify whether a user has successfully logged into the site, or to find out whether the computer (and probably its user) has visited the website before. 3.2.3.2. This site uses cookies – small text files that are placed on your machine to help the site provide a better user experience. In general, cookies are used to retain user preferences, store information for things like shopping baskets, and provide anonymised tracking data to third party applications like Google Analytics. As a rule, cookies will make your browsing experience better. However, you may prefer to disable cookies on this site and on others. The most effective way to do this is to disable cookies in your browser. We suggest consulting the Help section of your browser or taking a look at the About Cookies website which offers guidance for all modern browsers. You can also disable cookies by declining all in the pop-up window, entering the website's homepage [www.nagyedi.com](http://www.nagyedi.com).

3.2.3.3. If you leave a comment on our site you may opt in to saving your name, email address, phone and website in cookies. These are for your convenience so that you do not have to fill in your details again when you leave another comment. These cookies will last for one year.

3.2.3.4. If you visit our login page, we will set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser.

3.2.3.5. When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for a year. If you select "Remember Me", your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

3.2.3.6. If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie will be saved in your browser. This cookie includes no personal data and simply indicates the post ID of the article you just edited. It expires after 1 day.

### **3.2.4. Newsletter subscription**

3.2.4.1. When you sign up for any of our newsletters from us by completing the newsletter sign up form, we collect your name and email address. We will also record the time and date of completion.

3.2.4.2. You may unsubscribe from receiving further newsletters and updates at any time by simply clicking the unsubscribe link provided in all communications you receive.

## **4. Information you provide to us**

4.1. Your privacy is important to us. By providing personal information such as your name and email address via the forms on this website, you agree to us contacting you with regard to the information you request. We will also record the time, date and the specific form you completed.

4.2. We will not pass your details to any other government department or third party.

4.3. Correspondence and enquiries: when you make an enquiry or correspond with us for any reason, whether by email or via our contact form or by phone, we will retain your information for as long as it takes to respond to and resolve your enquiry, and for 36 further month(s), after which point we will archive your information.

4.4. Newsletter: we retain the information you used to sign up for our newsletter for as long as you remain subscribed (i.e. you do not unsubscribe).

## **5. How we secure your information**

5.1. We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to secure your information and to protect it against unauthorised or unlawful use and accidental loss or destruction, including:

5.1.2. only sharing and providing access to your information to the minimum extent necessary, subject to confidentiality restrictions where appropriate, and on an anonymised basis wherever possible;

5.1.3. using secure servers to store your information;

5.1.4. verifying the identity of any individual who requests access to information prior to granting them access to information;

5.1.5. using Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) software to encrypt any payment transactions you make on or via our website;

5.1.6. only transferring your information via closed system or encrypted data transfers.

## **6. Google Analytics**

6.1. Google Analytics is a web analysis service provided by Google. Google utilises the data collected to track and examine the use of websites, to prepare reports on its activities and share them with other Google services. Google may use the data collected to contextualize and personalize the ads of its own advertising network.

## **7. Embedded content from other websites**

7.1. Articles on this site may include embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website.

7.2. These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website. This Website may, from time to time, provide links to other websites. We have no control over such websites and are not responsible for the content of these websites. This privacy policy does not extend to your use of such websites. You are advised to read the privacy policy or statement of other websites prior to using them.

## **8. How long we retain your data**

8.1. If you leave a comment, the comment and its metadata are retained indefinitely. This is so we can recognise and approve any follow-up comments automatically instead of holding them in a moderation queue.

8.2. For users that register on our website (if any), we also store the personal information they provide in their user profile. All users can see, edit, or delete their personal information at any time. Website administrators can also see and edit that information.

## **9. What rights you have over your data**

If you have an account on this site, and have left comments, you can request to receive an exported file of the personal data we hold about you, including any data you have provided to us. You can also request that we erase any personal data we hold about you. This does not include any data we are obliged to keep for administrative, legal, or security purposes. 10.1. Visitor comments may be checked through an automated spam detection service.
